Description of Prizes

Prize of the "International Society of Surgery"

The prize of the "International Society of Surgery/Société Internationale de Chirurgie" (ISS/SIC) is awarded to the surgeon who has published work which has made **the most notable and useful contribution to surgical science**. The prize winner needs not to be a member of the ISS/SIC.

Robert Danis Prize

The Robert Danis Prize is awarded to the surgeon who has made the **most important and personal contribution to the fields of trauma (including skeletal fractures), burns or critical care**. The awardee must be a national of one of the countries represented at the ISS/SIC. It is not necessary for the candidate to be a member of the ISS/SIC.

René Leriche Prize

The René Leriche Prize is awarded to the surgeon who has made the **most significant contribution to surgery of the arteries, veins, or heart**. It is not necessary for the candidate to be a member of the ISS/SIC.

ISS/SIC Honorary Membership

Recipients of Honorary Membership shall be members of undoubted international reputation who have rendered distinguished services to the ISS/SIC. They have all of the rights of Active Members but are not required to pay dues or assessments. They shall receive all of the publications of the ISS/SIC without charge.

Instructions for submission of nominations

Nominations for prizes and Honorary Membership are by invitation. Personal applications for an award are not considered. Each prize is awarded to an individual and not to an institution or an association. Candidates will not be considered for a prize unless nominated on an official form by three members of the ISS/SIC who are familiar with the candidate's contribution. The completed form must be in the English language, typewritten, and accompanied by the candidate's curriculum vitae and bibliography. The completed nomination forms must be received by the Secretary General of the ISS/SIC no later than December 31, the year before the incoming congress in order to assure processing by the Executive and Nominating Committee at their regular meetings. The nominations will be reviewed by the Executive Committee of the ISS/SIC who will make the final decisions. The decisions by the Executive Committee will not be appealable.
